#### **Book Club**


Interested in joining the Book Club? Contact the library as soon as possible! We order copies through interlibrary loan for participants!

#### Paddington Bear Children's Tea


Tickets are on sale now for the Paddington Bear Children's Tea on Sunday, May 19th, for both the 1:30 and 3:30 PM seatings.


Adult tickets are \$20 each, while children's tickets cost \$10. They are on sale at the front desk of the library.



For pre-k - 3rd grade. Wind down after school with great read alouds and a craft. Then pick out your books for the week!


